RESOLUTION 21-05

**A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE USE AND FEES FOR THE
LAKE COUNTY LANDFILL**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners determines and declares it is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the order, comfort, and convenience of the County of Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, owns and operates a solid waste disposal site for the deposit of refuse and is empowered to do so pursuant to 30-11-107(1)(K)C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Lake County Resolution No. 15-39 amended the use and fees and certain regulations for the use of the Lake County Landfill set forth in Exhibit "B" of Lake County Resolution No. 15-39, and

WHEREAS, after a public hearing, the Board has determined that some of the fees and certain regulations for the use of the Lake County Landfill should be adjusted/modified and revised as identified in the attached Exhibits "A" and "B"; and

WHEREAS, the Board, upon conducting said public hearing, now determines the adoption of the fees and certain regulations set forth within the attached Exhibits "A" and "B" would be in the best interest of the County and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAKE COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners approves and adopts the fees and certain regulations for use of the Lake County Landfill as set forth within the attached Exhibits "A" and "B".

Section 2. All fees and regulations previously adopted by the Board for the use and operation of the Lake County Landfill, which are inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed and rescinded.

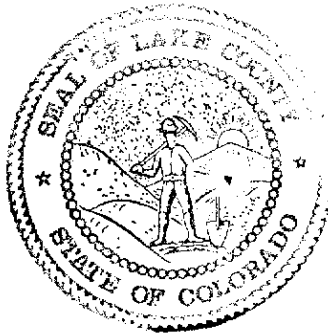
Section 3. Notwithstanding of the provisions contained within this Resolution or its Exhibits, the Board hereby reserves the right to waive, in full or in part, landfill fees and/or regulations for the certain public community events or programs promoting the cleanup of Lake County, such waiver or partial waiver of fees to be approved by the Board at any regular or special meeting.

Section 4. The Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption. However, the fee Schedule as set forth in Exhibit "A" will take effect on March 1, 2021.

Section 5. A certified copy of this resolution shall be posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the Lake County Courthouse and published in the Herald Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation within the County.

Additional Fees and Definitions

All loads that are not secured and covered with a tarp will be charged a double fee for that load on that day.

"Out of County" As that term/phrase is used in the foregoing schedule mean: that trash, refuse or solid waste which originates outside the geographic boundaries of Lake County Colorado.

"Messy Dumper" as the term/phrase is used in the foregoing schedule to will apply to any user of the landfill who violates any of the rules and regulations related to the operation of the landfill.

EXHIBIT "B"

In order to promote the safety, orderly conduct, integrity and longevity of the Lake County Landfill, the following rules and regulations pertaining to its operation are hereby established:

HOURS OF OPERATION:

- ◆ Friday – Tuesday 8 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. excepting holidays.
- ◆ The Landfill will be closed Wednesday and Thursday to the General Public.
- ◆ No loads greater than four (4) yards allowed one half hour before closing.

CHECK IN AND PAYMENT:

- * All persons are required to check in at landfill gate and declare the contents of their load, i.e.: household refuse, batteries, tires, oil, appliances, scrap, slash etc.
- * Entrance in the landfill will only be allowed for the purpose of depositing refuse and solid waste.
- * The fee for all loads will be calculated and rounded to the nearest yard.
- * The landfill will accept payment in cash, by check, with proper identification, or by credit card.
- * All loads must be "secured" and "covered".
- * No hazardous materials, no hot smoldering material, no liquids such as paints, stain, battery acid, chemicals or oil and antifreeze will be accepted in the landfill.
- * All electronics must be recycled and left at the gate/recycling center before entering the landfill. **THIS IS A STATE LAW.**

GENERAL DESIGNATION AND USE OF LANDFILL AREAS:

- ☒ Traffic cones and signs will be utilized to direct traffic to the appropriate areas of the landfill and cones and signs will identify the face of the landfill where the refuse/solid waste must be delivered. Cones shall not be disturbed or buried by solid waste.
- ☒ All loads shall be delivered between the cones identifying the drop off face area, (which cones will be approximately fifty (50) feet – seventy-five (75) feet apart).
- ☒ Delivery of refuse/solid waste shall be between the designated cones as close to the face of the landfill as practical.
- ☒ Entrance to the landfill tipping face shall be straight and parallel with the cones.

SPECIAL AREAS RESERVED FOR THE
DEPOSIT OF CERTAIN MATERIALS:

- * Tires may only be deposited in the area designated for tires.
- * Slash may only be deposited in the area designated for slash.
- * Scrap metal may only be deposited in the scrap metal trailer or a scrap metal designated area.
- * Oil and antifreeze may be deposited in the area designated for these liquids and containers disposed of properly.
- * Lead acid batteries may only be deposited in the area designated for batteries.
- * Refrigerators and freezers will only be accepted, with front door/doors removed and can only be deposited in the area designated at the recycling building.
- * Concrete may only be delivered in the area designated for concrete as close to the concrete pile face as practical.
- * Asphalt must be recycled at the Lake County Airport Pit. Arrangements to gain access to the pit must be made 48 Hours ahead of requested disposal as this site is MSHA regulated.
- * Pipe and wire must be cut to eight (8) foot or smaller lengths prior to deposit.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- ☒ Children and dogs must stay in a vehicle for safety reasons.
- ☒ No scavenging or waiting within the landfill.
- ☒ Individuals utilizing the landfill must be considerate and respectful to one another and to the landfill personnel.
- ☒ The imposition of a "messy dumper" fee two (2) times within a six (6) month period will, upon a third offense, subject the violator to an automatic six (6) month suspension of the right to utilize the landfill.
- ☒ The County reserves the right to refuse to receive all solid waste and will refuse landfill privileges to anyone who fails to pay the required fees, specifically including the "messy dumper" fee.

RIGHT OF APPEAL

Anyone utilizing the landfill is entitled to contest a designation of "messy dumper" by appealing the designation or assessment to the Board of County Commissioners, the forms for such appeal as well as the rules applicable to the hearing upon the appeal will be available at the Office of the Lake County Clerk and Recorder.
